Dear colleagues,

Mass spectrometry (MS) and spectroscopy (e.g. NMR, ESR, ...) have become major analytical techniques in almost all fields of science, ranging from life sciences, marine sciences, nano- and material-sciences, to environmental sciences.

The recently established cross-faculty **Kiel Network of Analytical Spectroscopy and Mass Spectrometry** aims to stimulate discussions amongst the main drivers of these technologies. Furthermore, we invite potential users of our technologies to stimulate novel developments in our field.

One of the major activities of the network is the establishment of a **regular seminar series** in which both methodological aspects and applications of mass spectrometry and analytical spectroscopy will be **presented by the groups involved** in the network.

The **first talk in this seminar series** will be given by Prof. Andreas Tholey (Proteomics & Bioanalytics, CAU) and cover both methodological developments as well as applications of

“LC-MS based protein analytics, proteomics and bioanalytics”

performed in his group.

After the talk there will be the opportunity to visit the Tholey labs (which are in only 50 m distance of the lecture hall; max. 20 visitors).

The organizers invite all interested group leaders, PostDocs and PhD-students from CAU and other research institutions in Kiel working in (analytical) method development, or applying MS or spectroscopic technologies. We kindly ask you to forward this announcement to all interested colleagues!

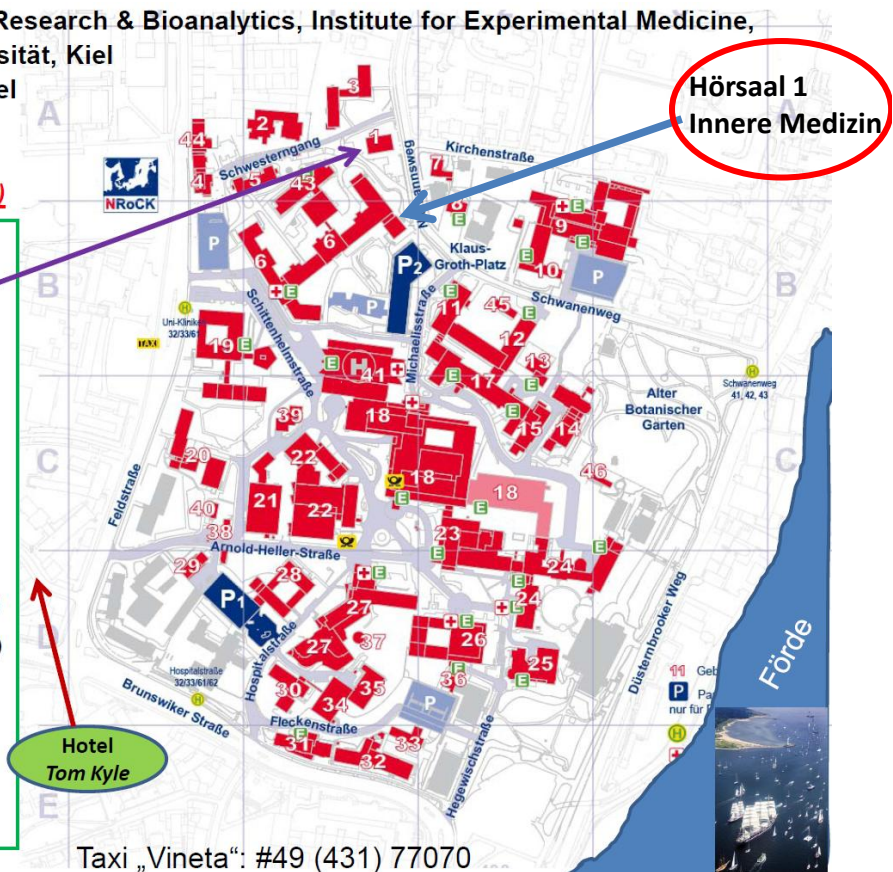
